Why is this session being organised?

- The CEOS Plenary (Biarritz) and the <u>Oceania Geospatial Symposium</u> (OGS) in New Caledonia (Noumea) are held during the same week
- Both events are strongly supported by CNES (CEOS Chair 2022), with GEO as a cornerstone.
- Global strategic context with increased focus on the Indo-Pacific region,
- An opportunity to directly connect international satellite data providers to a regional stakeholders and users' community with specific needs, to exchange visions and agree on pathways to increase EO data uptake to improve decision making and peoples' lives.


As a co-lead of the GEO Pacific Islands Advisory Group (PIAG), Australia (CSIRO together with Geoscience Australia) has been supporting the OGS planning. The event includes a <u>GEO Track Day</u> (December 1st) coorganised by GEO SEC and other GEO PIAG co-leads (France, China, USA) which will be concluded by this joint CEOS/OGS session.

Yana Gevorgyan (GEO SEC Director) will attend the OGS in person to discuss with representatives and endusers from the Pacific Islands, Countries and Territories (PICTs) to improve GEO's understanding of the region's landscapes, assets and needs in terms of EO data, and will contribute to this session.

Building on ongoing efforts to increase engagement between PICTs and the global community (GEO and CEOS), this session primarily aims to:

- Connect and better understand stakeholders' landscape to improve coordination on EO activities
 - Hear about application cases and their impacts using CEOS datasets, and EO needs, and observation gaps, from the PICTs
 - Demonstrate existing activities over the Pacific
- Agree on clear collaboration pathways to increase EO data uptake in the region

Planning this special session with external partners has been a cross-cutting activity: suggested by OGS (initial discussions were held in July with CNES, as CEOS Chair and OGS co-organizer, and GEO PIAG including CSIRO), this event has been co-designed by OGS, CEOS Chair, SIT Chair and CEO who have been working closely with other CEOS bodies including the SEO. We aim to deliver a "CEOS presentation" as inclusive as possible demonstrating CEOS's existing role and potential collaboration avenues to meet our objectives. Designed as a 'two-way' event, the session, moderated by Jean Massenet (OGS main organiser, New-Caledonia THEIA Regional Animation Network), will include:
