

- Overall CEOS Chair Theme of Unlocking EO for Society
- A renewed focus on improving public services, making them more efficient and more productive to improve citizens lives.
- * Public services "interventions and services intended to address public needs and interests, that are delivered by government, public sector agencies, or private or voluntary organisations with public funding"
- Examples (UK perspective) include public health and social care, emergency services, transport, housing & urban planning, broadcasting, law and regulation enforcement, food production,

nature and environmental health, climate change mitigation and adaptation, etc













Unlocking EO for Public Service - The role of space

- CEOS agencies are aware that satellite EO has the potential to play a much bigger role in delivering efficient public services.
- We need to extract, exploit and demonstrate the value of Earth observation data to enhance society, boost economic growth and improve people's lives.
- Demonstrating success across the CEOS community and learning from others will also help us to secure future investment in EO and encourage uptake.
- CEOS Chair team wants to drive discussion and knowledge exchange between CEOS entities on 'what works to drive usage': tools, mechanisms, interventions, programmes, who pays and 'what benefits have already been seen' have benefits been captured, quantified? How do you measure success?

- * What are the services and activities that work now? What benefits have been realised? Could this be duplicated elsewhere?
- * What new opportunities are there for EO in public services?
- What interventions do CEOS Agencies and associated Governments implement to encourage use of EO data in their countries /regions?
