Motivation for our activities but also for the WGCV work structure

- The changing CEOS member agency needs, especially for new members and or changing mission portfolios and Earth Observation applications
- The requirements of the different new CEOS activities, including:
 - Support of the other CEOS Working Groups
 - Cooperation with the Virtual Constellations
 - The CEOS responses to task forces such as for Carbon (2013/14) or for the water cycle (WSIST, 2015)
 - New activities such as the sensor cross-cutting items such as DEMs, cloud masking, etc.

Organization

- Implementation of WGCV secretariat
 - Virtual PoC per e-mail
 - Currently secretariat under consolidation
 - Contract this summer will allow to initiate/support more activities
 - Transition of WGCV secretariat materials from CSA
- Goal for the coming period (until next meeting)
 - Secretariat more visible for whole WGCV
 - Set-up of an effective inter-plenary communication
 - Systematic search for additional interested members
 - Strengthening of a coordination "structure" with other CEOS entities





Survey about active WGCV membership

- Membership stable but can be extended
- Extension valuable to have also the critical mass for new activities
- Screening "strategy" for (associate) members:
 - Targeted search for possible candidates screening their "Cal/Val interests"
 - Set-up of "personalized" letters or direct contact
 - Special sessions addressing their needs for inclusion
 - Also combined effort with CEO/DCEO
- Possible grow in Asia / Pacific area (Request by a near-future member for participation)
- Opportunities also in Europe
- Need to be complemented by sub-group & task group membership survey (Note: AI from WGCV # 38)
- <u>Comment: I am happy to welcome IOCCG now and JAXA again in 2016</u>






Reporting vs. CEOS-SEC / SIT and CEO

- Monthly telecon of CEOS-SEC (routine)
- Dedicated telecon of SIT team with chair and vice-chair about status, specific needs and proposals for coming UN-COP congress
- CEOS-SIT meeting: WGCV presentation
- Discussion about CEOS Work Plan 2015 2017 with CEO/SIT:

WGCV Chair team decided not to add / change any deliverable, because of the existing work load and the fact that those had to be agreed / synchronized with the WGCV.

Note: Two discussions during the WGCV #39 -> Deliverables and Carbon tasks





Interaction with other CEOS entities (I)

- In general, an interaction with another CEOS entity or outside CEOS shall be visible to all WGCV members and in good communication with the WGCV chairs.
- CEOS members are highly interested not to split or duplicate activities. Thus, the cooperation of VCs and WGs is currently on top!
- CEOS is based on best effort.
 Analysis / Clarification of own contributions in a cooperation context is very helpful for resource optimization but also for resource finding.
- "Marketing" of own activities (two examples):
 - Presentation of Interaction with SST-VC (progress reporting during WGCV 39)
 - Presentation @ WG-Climate plenary in March 2015





Interaction with other CEOS entities (II)

- Very "burning" topics on the agenda
 - The ingestion of Carbon action items in WGCV work plan
 - How do we interact with upcoming "Implementation Strategy Teams", e.g. "water cycle"
 - The reorganization of the <u>Land Surface Imaging Virtual Constellations</u>
- Systematic approach for upcoming topics for cooperation
 - What kind of topics in other CEOS entities can lead to an interaction with CEOS
 WGCV?
 - Special session(s) with topic-driven agenda:
 - Presentation of entity
 - Presentation specials addressing the bridge to Cal/Val
 - WGCV # 39 special session on Ocean Color





CEOS – WGCV planning meeting (I)

• Genesis

- Cross-cutting topics since several WGCV plenaries on the agenda
- Need for activities identified but a direct implementation was difficult
- Agreed AI (WGCV 38) to set-up a planning meeting
- Thanks to Bojan Bojkov (ESA) a planning meeting was held in Feb 2015
- Invitation to chairs, sub-group leads and topic experts

Specific Meeting Mission

To identify a road map considering boundary conditions for finding a most suitable recommendation how to make usage in *Earth Observation applications* of

- Digital Elevation Models (DEMs)
- Cloud masking
- Atmospheric correction

Most likely target: Recommendations shall be "inclusive"





CEOS – WGCV planning meeting (II)

General Meeting Mission

- Identify an approach how to set-up the above mentioned road map
- Take advantage by being informed about existing approaches (SCOPE-CM, GEWEX)
- Discuss such approaches for each of these three activities
- Develop a generalized approach: task approach
- Keep in mind the CEOS cosmos including update cycles of work plans, cooperation with other entities, etc.. and synchronize / adopt to it

General outcome

- Set-up of a roadmap for road map implementation of these activities
- Characterization / Definition of a "task approach" for such kind of activities
- Chairs and subgroup leads were obliged to think how to integrate in the ToRs (Question: Split of current work plan in ToRs and work plan)
